Re: H2018 An Act relative to employment protections for victims of abusive behavior

Dear Chair Cutler and Chair Jehlen,

I write to you regarding a bill to prevent employment discrimination that domestic abuse survivors face: H2018 *An Act relative to employment protections for victims of abusive behavior.*

Studies conducted have shown that 30 percent of these victims lose their jobs because of the domestic violence they faced. This is often due to the fact that employers are unwilling to provide reasonable accommodations to protect them from their abusers while in the workplace whether it be providing an extra day off to attend a court hearing or changing an employee's number. This results in an individual having to choose between their job and their safety.

This bill strengthens existing employment nondiscrimination by adding status as a victim of abusive behavior to the list of protected categories. It also would require that employees provide accommodation to and not discriminate against hiring employees who are victims of abusive behavior or who have family members who are victims of abusive behavior, if proof is provided.

When an individual has experienced domestic violence the last thing that one should have to worry about is keeping their job. I believe that this is an important step to protecting abuse survivors. I hope that the committee will report the bill out favorably.
