Re: H2355 – An Act to reduce atmospheric pollution.

Dear Chair Decker and Chair Comerford,

I respectfully request that you favorably report H.1958 – *An Act to reduce atmospheric pollution*.

This bill would expand MGL Section 31C of Chapter 111 to include the imposition of a local surcharge on commercial parking spaces and/or a cap on the number of such spaces available in any city or town. This bill includes the requirement of all funds derived from such surcharges to be paid directly to the town to be used for air pollution abatement and improvements in transportation infrastructure. This bill would encourage the use of public transit and carpools in place of single-occupant vehicles in order to decrease congestion and improve air quality for all Massachusetts citizens.
